

- Chant is for three players with three large drums each. Drums are bass drums or doubled headed toms, preferably with skin, distributed with each player having one of the three largest, one of the three smallest, and one of the three middle drums. Very soft bass drum or timpani mallets should be used.
- At "PROCREATION", rhythms "A-I" are played in any random order by each player, each with a different, unplanned, spontaneous sequence; however all nine rhythms must be performed in complete cycles with the indicated number of repetitions. At the completion of this process, each player repeats rhythm "J" until all players have found a communal tempo and played "J" three times in unison, before proceeding to "ARCADIA".
- All notes are played as softly as possible while generating a minimum resonance inherent to each drum. All strokes are kisses for the skins. The power of drums may be a quiet power, if only they could sing it so.


