In the string parts:

N = normal bow and vibrato

S.P. = sul ponticello

N.V. = non vibrato

Harmonic trill is an alternation between normal and light finger pressure, so that the sound is a mix of pitch indicated and harmonic at the fingering.

The sandpaper blocks in the percussion part should be large, such as 8.5x11 sheets against each other.
